Colour views from Negatives by E Charman



With 28 B&W views, twelve colour offered fills the order form, making 40 ample to offer from at least three photographers collections.

We continue with Ernest Charman's views however the quality of reproduction and negatives on some come out perfectly well, while others may on printing fail our usual standard, and those prints will be sent, although also with a credit being a reject. Some forty years lack of care in storage is now showing.

We have noticed the increase in other dealers prices for photos have crept up to 70 pence, whether hand printed or lab laser. Online are more!
