Colour views by Ernie Charman

Last month saw the last of the slides taken by Martin Piggott, of which we should remember views like these were taken for personal satisfaction and not for professional or monetary gain.

Some views of any collection can become very collectable which brings us to the Ernest Charman collection. Better known as Ernie, with his 1970's colour negatives. Never using slides, only now have we attempted to scan and reproduce his material for the first time into 6x4 prints since he ceased to offer his 'old postcard' sized views in the mid eighties. Before we purchased the negatives, unauthorised slides had been produced off those original views sold.

All we would ask is that enthusiasts respect Mr Charman and his efforts in supporting this Newsletter by buying genuine prints made direct from his own negatives in which provides, by way of detailed reverse labels, his due credit where it is deserved for his efforts as an enthusiast.

The quality of our B&W views such as from Mr Hutson and Mr Turley, have been excellent, however not everyone looks after negatives as well, with damp/moisture and easily scratched, some images may have been spoilt over many years in less than perfect storage.

Should subscribers wish to return any view considered not to their satisfaction, a credit would be provided for future Newsletter print orders following the questionable prints safe return.
