### The Last Brighton Trolleybuses

Holiday months for most, therefore August and September issues have been combined, with a variety of yet more unpublished views.

Eight views of Brighton's final trolleybuses from the original collection of the Late Jim Jones, along with six other vintage views, just possibly these may have been lent out well over ten years ago.

Barrie Hutson supplies another round of his unpublished historic views dated 1965 and 1967, again BH&D, Brighton Corporation and two views of Eastbourne Corporation. For B&W see page 3.

Previous issues have been to provide new views split between the Barrie Hutson collection and reprinting from our first catalogued 600 B&W negatives. This month we thought it was worth bringing out some of the views we consider have been missed by others from the late Jim Jones collection. The majority of the core Brighton and Southdown material was stripped from his collection years before we were offered the remains of these by his son Graham. There is a vast amount of other liveries and views, although a nice amount to go through yet within the colour slides, so with an as yet untouched John Piggott slides and barely started on the Mr Charman original negatives, there is a wealth of local material to bring out for years to come, in both B&W and Colour. Not available elsewhere.

### Colour views from Negatives by E Charman



All 6x4 prints at 50p

This month we have offered eleven views, all dated 1976/7 including the first Works Open Day, being that we are sequentially working through the earliest bundles purchased picking out anything mid seventies or earlier.

Initially it was thought that having already partly catalogued this collection in 2004 of at that time 2,500 negatives, it would be easy to use the original numbering system. Just how wrong we were, with dates and numbers jumping around even on the same negative strips, some having none at all. Therefore with a recommendation that we ought to dispense with those, we have chosen to provide our EC Series from one as we print them to 6x4 for the first time. Where the original number makes sense and available, this can be seen on the reverse labels & database.

To avoid any confusion, ALL our 6x4 prints are at the same price of 50 pence, whether colour or B&W. Only the 9x6 are at the higher price. A revised form is now attached making this easier when ordering all or most of the colour prints. Only very few prints have been returned after ordering on a customers preference.
