Although time just does not allow for more than 28 B&W views, there is cope at times for more colour images, the latter taken in number sequence, not picked by liveries.

The vehicles as originally owned covered this month are 9 BH&D, 7 Brighton Corporation, 23 Southdown, some with new operators.

To clarify, views offered at 6x4 are not as an approval set, however prints returned in unmarked condition will gladly be credited against future orders, if subscribers consider any print not acceptable. Mindful print quality is directly related to the age of film material, lens and camera used by the original photographers. Slides will not be as sharp as the negatives, with our tram and trolleybus views well sought after.
